# KEYS TO EFFECTIVE FEEDBACK

Grant Wiggins, in an article written for ASCD, referenced seven keys to effective feedback. Over the next few weeks, we will break down these keys, as both students and teachers benefit from effective feedback as this drives instruction in all of our classrooms.

Feedback should be goal referenced. A great example would be a person struggling to hit a baseball hard. Without feedback,

this person will definitely not improve without someone helping him or her with this goal.

Incorrect feedback would be something to the effect of letting the person know they are missing many pitches. That would be the same as if a teacher just gave a grade on an assignment and did not let the student know what they did

wrong.

Great feedback would be telling the hitter that each time they missed, they were picking their head up, yet each time they made good contact, the head was down and on the ball through contact. Letting students know what they did correctly models what they need to continue to reach their goal, albeit at the plate or in the classroom.
